

The Town Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Landi at 7:01 PM with the pledge to the flag and a moment of silence.

Present were: Supervisor Landi, Councilman Gaddy, Councilman Queipo, Councilman Wells, and Councilman Polacco. Highway Superintendent Ed Moore, Town Justice Richard Alberstadt, Code Enforcement Officer Bob Cologero and 4 residents were also in attendance.

Supervisor Landi made the motion, seconded by Councilman Gaddy to accept the minutes of the Organization, Town Board and Town Workshop minutes for the month of January as reviewed prior to this meeting. All approved.

Supervisor Landi read the Supervisor's report and Town Clerk Weiss read the Town Clerk's report.

The general and highway bills were reviewed by the Town Board.

Intrafund Transfers

Councilman Polacco made the motion, seconded by Councilman Wells for the following transfers:

Transfer \$25,000 from checkbook to A230.3 Building Repairs & Expansion Reserve, Transfer from A230.7 Supervisor's Investment into A1620.4 Town Hall Contractual \$23,136.97 for generator, and Transfer from A3620.4 Code Enforcement Officer Contractual into A3620.12 Code Enforcement Officer Secretary \$820.08 to cover expenses. All approved.

General and Highway Bills

A motion was made by Supervisor Landi and seconded by Councilman Gaddy to pay the following general bills Claim #25 thru #57, totaling \$18,989.23 and highway bills Claim #58 thru #74, totaling \$9,754.38. All approved. (See minute book for a breakdown of the actual bills).

Councilman Wells reported that the Town Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, March 24th at 10AM with a rain date of Sunday, March 25th at 10AM. Councilman Wells is also working on the details for the Summer Recreation Program.

Councilman Polacco reported that Code Enforcement/Building Inspector Cologero received \$490 in fees during the month of January. There have been some complaints about the Solar Farm – mainly about the amount of trees taken down. Cypress Creek has finished clearing the land and will be back in April to continue with the project.

Highway Superintendent Moore reported Councilman Polacco will be working with him to have a start-up schedule for the generator. The Highway Department did a great job with the last few snow/ice storms

Councilman Gaddy has no report from the Animal Control Officer.

Councilman Queipo had nothing to report on his committees. He reported that Town Historian, Linda Queipo, was on WKNY radio discussing the history of the Town of Kingston. She may be invited back for their March 3rd show.

New Business

Councilman Polacco made the motion, seconded by Supervisor Landi to purchase a new sander with a cost of \$6,200. A discussion followed. Highway Superintendent Moore, stated that the sander was over 20 years old. All approved the motion.

Supervisor Landi made the motion, seconded by Councilman Queipo to adopt Local Law #3 – Zoning Law – Petitions. All approved.

Questions and Comments

A resident questioned who the flood administrator was for the Town. He had received a letter from FEMA concerning elevation studies which are needed to help FEMA determine the flood insurance rates. Councilman Polacco will get back to the resident detailing which agencies he had contacted when he got a similar letter.

Motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Wells, seconded by Councilman Gaddy. All approved. The meeting was adjourned at 7:25PM.
